
## Bringing Bluegrass to the Hudson Valley

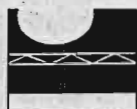

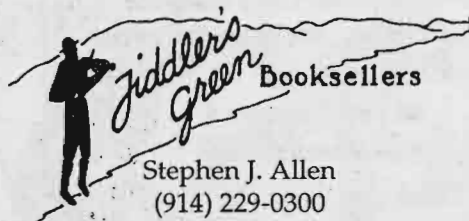

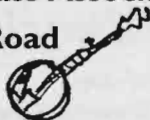
